NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page e.g. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under **My Profile > My Nominations** (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

Convenors Sports Reports 2018

Convenors are asked to submit a report on their sport, ASAP but at the latest by Wednesday 31 October. The report should include a team list, well as noting players or staff selected to higher honours. A written report on the team's performance at the PSSA or All School's Championship should be included. Finally any recommendations for 2019 should be listed. Thank you to those that have already submitted their reports.

CIS Awards 2018

As many sports have now reached the SSA level, **convenors are reminded that award nominations are now due in all sports with the exception of primary athletics and boys and girls cricket, which are yet to compete at the PSSA Level.** A basic outline of award criteria is provided below, to access the full [Award Criteria](#) follow the link. Thank you to those convenors that have already been online to submit their award nominations

Medallion Nominations

CIS medallions are awarded to a student that has been selected in and competes in an either a NSWPSSA or a NSW All Schools Team at the SSA Championships. These nominations are done automatically.

Reds (Primary Award)

These are generally awarded to the best two primary students per sport /per gender, provided they have reached the SSA level in 2018.

Blues (Secondary Award)

These are generally awarded to the best two students per sport/per gender, provided they have reached the SSA level in 2018. The convenor nominates them through their CIS Team Management Area. There are some specific awards criteria mainly relating to individual sports e.g. swimming, athletics, cross country and a few team sports. Please refer to the CIS Awards criteria available on the Awards page of the CIS website.

Red or Blue Bars are awarded to those students whom, for a second year, fulfil the Blue or Red criteria in the same sport.

A Blue with Honours is awarded to an athlete who after representing CIS and NSW All Schools has been named in a national team at the SSA Championships, or where no national team is named achieved at the highest possible level.

Reds, Blues, Bars and Honours are all nominated by the **convenor**. Award Nominations are being accepted in all sports, once the SSA Championships has been completed.

Convenors please assist by nominating for these sports ASAP. If you have any queries about your nominations or how to place them, please contact CIS. Any CIS team in consideration for the Outstanding Primary or Secondary team of the Year should also be nominated.

Heads of Sport and Award Nominations

Medallions, Red and Blue Nomination lists will be forwarded to schools for checking by Friday 16 November. This is your opportunity to check eligible students from your school have been nominated for an award and to contact CIS if you feel that one of your students has been missed. Please check that the student meets the CIS Awards Criteria before contacting CIS.

All Heads of Sport are asked to forward action photos to CIS of all students that have been nominated for a Red or Blue Award in preparation for the Awards Evening to be held in February. This will enable us to prepare for the Awards Evening over the holiday period and reduce the pressure in the chaotic first few weeks of Term 1 2019 for everyone.

The Awards Committee will meet in mid-December to confirm the award recipients for 2018. At this time, the **Outstanding Primary Sports boy and Sportsgirl as well as Secondary Sportsman and Sportswoman for 2018** will be determined. Should you feel you have a student that may be in the running for one of these awards please forward any supporting information from the school that may assist the Awards Committee with their decision.

CIS Sports App 2018

All staff, and students nominated to attend a CIS Trials or Championship are required to download the App, **PRIOR** to the event. This will provide staff and students with the latest information regarding the trials for their sport, to access the app go to Google Play or the App store and download AISNSW. Once downloaded enter the relevant event code:

for all primary sports – primary18

for all Secondary Sports – secondary18

For windows phone or PC Users open any browser and go to <http://app.entegy.com.au/> insert relevant event code.

Please note that the Apps will be constantly updated until the event. Please keep checking for updates. When downloading the App please allow “Push Notifications”. The App can be updated by clicking on the wheel in the top right hand corner of the screen.

N.B If you downloaded the App last year you need to put in one of the event codes listed above to access the 2018 information for your sport.

Don't forget to refresh your app to ensure you have the latest information on your sport. Go to the little wheel in the top right hand corner of the App

SPORTS RESULTS

NSWPSSA Boys Cricket

Three weeks out from our trials, there had been no response from anyone to Convene, Manager or Coach this team so we were not even sure it could go ahead.

Gordon Bromhead, CSSA then came forward to take on the Convening role and from then on things changed. The King's School offered their magnificent facilities for the trials and **Russel McCool**, The King's School, IPSHA and **Trent Hemsworth**, The Scots School, Bathurst, HICES each took on the role of Co-Manager/Coach.

The result of the work of these staff with the help of James Bruce, Convenor 2017, and all who assisted at the trials was the selection of a team which went on to win the NSWPSSA Championships in Barooga last week. After three days of wins against Sydney South West, Sydney West and South Coast, CIS achieved a place in the final, and, after scoring 198 managed to bowl Sydney East out for 81 to take out the Championships. An outstanding result.

Special congratulations to **Preston Lee**, Mosman Prep, IPSHA, **Tanmay Mehta**, Broughton Anglican College, NASSA and **Lachlan Ritchie**, Inaburra, CSSA who were selected in the NSWPSSA Team for the School Sport Australia Championships in Bunbury WA in December.
