NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page e.g. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under [My Profile > My Nominations](#) (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

Award Nominations

Heads of Sport and Award Nominations

All list of Medallion, Red and Blue Nominations for 2018 is attached to the email that sent this newsletter. Heads of Sport are asked to check all eligible students from your school have been nominated for an award and to contact CIS if you feel that one of your students has been missed. Please check that the student meets the CIS Awards Criteria before contacting CIS. Any corrections or changes are required by Friday 29 November.

All Heads of Sport are asked to forward action photos to CIS of all students that have been nominated for a Red or Blue Award in preparation for the Awards Evening to be held in February. This will enable us to prepare for the Awards Evening over the holiday period and reduce the pressure in the chaotic first few weeks of Term 1 2019 for everyone.

The Awards Committee will meet in mid-December to confirm the award recipients for 2018. At this time, the **Outstanding Primary Sports boy and Sportgirl as well as Secondary Sportsman and Sportswoman for 2018** will be determined. Should you feel you have a student that may be in the running for one of these awards please forward any supporting information from the school that may assist the Awards Committee with their decision.

CIS Awards 2018

Please ensure that all students from your sport, selected in either a NSW All Schools or a NSWPSA team who went on to represent at the SSA Championship have had their status changed to either PSSA or All Schools. Thank



you to those convenors that have already been online to submit their award nominations,

Medallion Nominations

CIS medallions are awarded to a student that has been selected in and competes in an either a NSWPSA or a NSW All Schools Team at the SSA Championships. These nominations are done automatically.

Reds (Primary Award)

These are generally awarded to the best two primary students per sport /per gender, provided they have reached the SSA level in 2018.

Blues (Secondary Award)

These are generally awarded to the best two students per sport/per gender, provided they have reached the SSA level in 2018. The convenor nominates them through their CIS Team Management Area. There are some specific awards criteria mainly relating to individual sports e.g. swimming, athletics, cross country and a few team sports. Please refer to the CIS Awards criteria available on the Awards page of the CIS website.

Red or Blue Bars are awarded to those students whom, for a second year, fulfil the Blue or Red criteria in the same sport.

A Blue with Honours is awarded to an athlete who after representing CIS and NSW All Schools has been named in a national team at the SSA Championships, or where no national team is named achieved at the highest possible level.

Reds, Blues, Bars and Honours are all nominated by the **convenor**. Award Nominations are being accepted in all sports, once the SSA Championships has been completed.

Urgent Update: School Team Relay Events – 1 March 2019

Expression of Interest Form due on Monday 26 November

Due to increasing safety concerns there will be a cap on the number of teams per sector, per event in 2019. Each sector can enter 60 teams in an event, making the maximum number of teams per event 180. To assist CIS to meet the entry criteria and maximise CIS entries, all schools entering teams in the Schools' Team Relay event **MUST** submit an Expression of Interest Form. Schools that do not submit an EOI form will not be able to enter the Triathlon Teams Event. Schools are to state the number of teams they will be entering in each event. Each team is to be ranked from 1 – 10. This does not guarantee entry for these teams into the competition. Once the **Expression of Interest (EOI) Form submission closes on Monday 26 November**, CIS will allocate the number of teams each school can enter into the event. Schools will be notified of how many teams they can enter in each event by Friday 29 November. Please note teams entered in an event above the school's allocation or that do not submit an EOI Form **will not be accepted**.

CIS Football Cup 2019 – Entries are now being accepted.

It is good to see interest in the CIS Football Cup 2019 already growing with a number of schools enquiring as to when they can submit entries. Entries will open next Monday 12 November 2018. Please make sure that you read the CIS Football Cup rules as there have been some slight changes for 2019. These can be accessed under Related Documents on the Football Cup page of the CIS website. Remember entries will close on Friday 7 December 2018 and CIS does not accept Late Entries, so start getting organised!

As the CIS Calendar is not being rolled over to 2019 this year, the nomination form will display as the 2018 Nomination Form. Please ignore this, and lodge the online nomination. We will be able to pick up your entry from the date you submitted it, and enter you in the 2019 competition.

NSWPSSA GIRLS CRICKET CHAMPIONSHIPS
