NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page eg. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under **My Profile > My Nominations** (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

In October last year, CIS became a company in its own right, a separate entity. Schools are now the members of CIS and as such should have submitted an Application for Membership form.

If a school wishes to access the CIS Representative pathway in 2018, they must have submitted the Membership Application form and be affiliated to one of the CIS Member Sports Associations. Forms were emailed to principals in October last year.

A list of schools that have already submitted their application forms along with a membership form has been attached to the email that sent this newsletter. If your school does not appear on the list and the school is



intending to access the CIS representative pathway please submit a form indicating the Eligible Sports Association which you belong to e.g.. IPSHA or AICES. CIS Website 2018

There have been no changes to the way the CIS website operates. However a few reminders will help all staff get back into the swing of things.

Reminders

1. Teachers must be a contact to the AIS website to be able to nominate students from their school to participate in CIS Trials/ Championships. New teachers will need to go to the top right hand corner of the website and click on Sign Up. Follow the instructions. Once you have signed up your principal will also need to approve you as a contact to the AIS website. When you activate your registration by clicking on the link in the email it will automatically send an email to the principal asking them to approve you.

2. Change of Details

Teachers that have changed schools are reminded to update their details on the website.

3. Nominating Students for a CIS Sport

- I. LOGIN to the website
- II. Once logged in, to access the form go to the Sport you wish to nominate in. Each sport page has



been loaded with the relevant nomination form, either Individual or Team. A link to the form can be found on the right hand side of the page under Nominations, simply click on "Nominate a Team or Individual" and follow the prompts. Only sports using an individual nomination form can be nominated by the school. Team nomination forms are submitted by the association.

Please Note: When nominating a student for a sport it is imperative that care is taken to ensure two things:

a. **Dates Of Birth Are Accurate.** Every nomination requires a date of birth to be entered. This is not just to verify the students age but also enables a student selected in a CIS Team to access the online uniform system. If a student tries to order uniform and puts in their birth date and nomination code (which they will be given at the trials if they are selected) and it does not match the date of birth against their name in the system, they will be denied access to the uniform order process.

b. **Names Are Spelt Correctly** e.g. we do not want Patrick Williams entered this way for one sport and as Pat Williams for another. Try and use their full proper name as it appears on official class lists. This enables us to track the student across all sports attaching their CIS activities to the one contact.

III. If you are having trouble submitting a nomination through the website **CONTACT CIS BEFORE NOMINATIONS CLOSE.**

4. Always Check your nominations have been received by

- a) Going to your My Nominations area under My Profile (blue ribbon at top left of screen). If the nomination is not listed here CIS does not have it. Resubmit or contact CIS
- b) Using the Check Nominations button on the main Menu of the CIS website

Please note that the Apps will be constantly updated until the event. Please keep checking for updates. When downloading the App please allow "Push Notifications". The App can be updated by clicking on the wheel in the top right hand corner of the screen.
