## NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page e.g. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under **My Profile > My Nominations** (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

## NOMINATIONS FOR CIS SPORT

You can do this by going to your “My Nominations” area. If you can see the nomination there you know it has been received. If you cannot see it in your My Nomination area then try and resubmit.

### **Remember**

#### **4. Always check your nominations have been received by**

- a) Going to your My Nominations area under My Profile (blue ribbon at top left of screen). If the nomination is not listed here CIS does not have it. Resubmit or contact CIS
- b) Using the Check Nominations button on the main Menu of the CIS website

## SPORTS UPDATES

### **Secondary AFL - Age Eligibility**

For CIS AFL 15&U nominations, there are differing age eligibility for boys and girls.

Boys: turn 14 or 15 this year (born 2003 or 2004 only)

Girls: turn 15 or less this year (born in 2003 or after).

### **CIS Sports App 2018**

All staff, and students nominated to attend a CIS Trials or Championship are required to download the App, **PRIOR** to the event. This will provide staff and students with the latest information regarding the trials for their sport, to access the app go to Google Play or the App store and download AISNSW. Once downloaded enter the relevant event code:

for all primary sports – primary18

for all Secondary Sports – secondary18

For windows phone or PC Users open any browser and go to <http://app.entegy.com.au/> insert relevant event code.



Please note that the Apps will be constantly updated until the event. Please keep checking for updates. When downloading the App please allow "Push Notifications". The App can be updated by clicking on the wheel in the top right hand corner of the screen.

**N.B If you downloaded the App last year you need to put in one of the event codes listed above to access the 2018 information for your sport.**

**Don't forget to refresh your app to ensure you have the latest information on your sport.**

## SPORTS RESULTS

### NSW All Schools Baseball Championship

The CIS team took the game right to NSWCHS jumping out to an aggressive early lead. Sebastian Matthews showed plenty of command on the mound, tying up the CHS hitters and restricting them to just 2 runs over his three innings of pitching. The runs however dried up and staving off the remarkably strong CHS batting line up proved too much and the final result 7-5. Much credit must go to the impressive calling of catcher Zachary Lawrence, who showed great maturity and game understanding to keep hitters off balance in an impressive display behind the plate.

The second game in a double header is a difficult time to display energy and this was no exception. CIS pitching and defence ran into trouble immediately against NSWCCC and after giving up six runs in the first inning were always chasing. Offensively though, our hitters were up against it and couldn't overcome the early deficit going down 12-3.

Our team had lost many of its experienced players from prior seasons and with such a young group have entered a "rebuilding phase". With all but three players from this team eligible for selection in 2019, our future looks particularly bright. We are extremely grateful to the coaching experience of Todd Southcombe (The Illawarra Grammar School – AICES), David Hyde (Richard Johnson Anglican School – CSSA) and Luke Adams (Rouse Hill Anglican School – AICES) all combining to assist in selecting and coaching the team and to all the time and effort invested by our Baseball Convenor and Team Manager, Adrian Carter (Redlands-ISA).

An outstanding display of springboard and platform diving skills enthralled the crowd at the Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre last Thursday.
