NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page e.g. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under **My Profile > My Nominations** (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

NSW All Schools AFL Championships

Girls

CIS defeated CHS-Riverina, but lost to CHS-Greater Sydney and CCC.

The final standings were: 1st CHS-Greater Sydney; 2nd CCC; 3rd CIS; and 4th CHS-Riverina.

CIS was also third in 2017, its inaugural year, but was much more competitive this year and can look forward to further improvement.

Zarlie Goldsworthy (Trinity Anglican College, Albury was CIS's MVP and was selected in the NSW All Schools team. Others to be selected are Louisa Mitchell (Pymble Ladies' College), Jayda Richardson (Moama Anglican Grammar School), Keely Rock (Pymble Ladies' College) and Casey Wynne (Bishop Druitt College).

A huge thank you to coaches Stuart Newman and Rebekah Mann, and to team manager Michael Jenkins who all did a wonderful job mentoring and assisting the players.

Boys

CIS fielded a very skilful fast team and none of the other teams could match them. In the grand final, CIS 9-11-65 defeated CCC South 0-2-2, where the game was two halves of twenty minutes. This is CIS's fourth win as a stand-alone team from six championships since 2013.

The final standings were: 1st CIS; 2nd CCC-South; 3rd CHS-Riverina South West; 4th CHS-Northern NSW; 5th CCC-North; 6th CHS-Riverina Murray; 7th CHS-Sydney; 8th CHS-South Coast; and 9th CHS-West Darling.

The CIS MVP for the championships was Billy Glanvill (The Riverina Anglican College, Wagga Wagga). Billy was selected in the NSW All Schools team along with Anthony De Pasquale (Moama Anglican Grammar School),



Ethan Grace (William Clarke College), Felix Rogers (Saint Ignatius' College) and Sam Stening (The Riverina Anglican College, Wagga Wagga). We wish these players all the best for the SSA Championships.

A huge thank you to coaches Matt Bedford and Mark Dicketts, and to team manager Brad Whale all of whom did a superb job of guiding the team to another State Championship.
