NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page e.g. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under **My Profile > My Nominations** (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

NOMINATIONS FOR CIS SPORT

A requirement of this role will be to attend the School Sport Australia 12 Years and Under Football Championships from Monday 17 – Friday 21 September 2018.

Applicants are required to be full time teachers of primary schools and their appointments are subject to approval from their Principal/Director and the Sports Coordination Officer of their School Sport Association.

It is expected that applicants hold their mandatory first aid, CPR and anaphylaxis certificates.

Sports App

Program

Start Lists

Start Lists are available on the CIS website, Meet Mobile and the primary swimming App. The most accurate start lists will be on Meet Mobile.

Live Results – Meet Mobile

CIS will once again be using Meet Mobile to assist with live results. A Flyer for Meet Mobile is loaded on the App and can be found under Related Documents on the Primary Swimming page of the website. Meet Mobile results now require a small subscription if you wish to access results.

To subscribe for results: Find a meet that is either in progress or completed, and go to events, and to an event that has results – that should trigger the screen to sign up for a subscription.

Pool Entry

Pool entry has been paid by all spectators and competitors in the CIS nominations levy. Entry to the pool will be free. The car park ticket will need to be validated to receive the \$15 flat rate.

Warm Up

Warm up procedures have been loaded on the app. Each association is to ensure that there warm up lane/lanes have supervision throughout the warm up period.

Marshalling

Swimming - Three calls will be announced and if swimmer doesn't show after that they will be scratched from the event. As at the PSSA Carnival, where if a Multi Class Competitor needs to be escorted to the marshalling area this is done by Association Team Management. At the CIS carnival associations are asked to educate their students by following the same procedure. Team managers will take Multi Class competitors to the marshalling area if an escort is required. Managers will need to determine which students need an escort at the beginning of the day. **Parents are not permitted in the Marshalling area**

Diving - All divers to report to the diving end of the pool for their event.

CIS Representative Team

The NSW CIS Primary Swim team will compete at the PSSA Swimming Championships on Wednesday 11 and Thursday 12 April whilst the NSW CIS Primary Diving Team will compete at the PSSA Diving Championships to be held on Wednesday 11 April

For both Swimming and Diving

Generally the top three places from each event are selected in the CIS Team and should go to the Shane Gould room on the day to be fitted for uniform and pay the levy.

A list of CIS Primary Swim and Dive Team Members will be posted on the website by Friday 23 March.

N.B. Swimmers who place first in the CIS 50m Freestyle Championship will be a member of the CIS All Age Freestyle Relay Team.

Officials

All officials are asked to sign in by 8:00am. Please report to the Results and Recording Room. You will need to



collect an officials shirt. Please ensure that you are familiar with the duty you have been assigned to. There will be an officials meeting in the Results and Recording Room at 8:30am

Team Managers

An association team managers meeting will be held at 8.00am in the recording room. All Managers need to attend, and will be required to collect their managers packs.

Coaches

All coaches **MUST** sign in at the recording room and get a coaches pass if they wish to be on pool deck. If a coach does not have a coaches' pass they will be asked to leave pool deck. These passes need to be returned at the end of the carnival. No coaches will be allowed in the results room or recorders room once they have signed on.

Parents and Spectators

No parents or spectators will be allowed on pool deck. Each association has been assigned an area in the grandstand. On arrival students need to check in with their team managers who will be in this area. 16 Years & Under Boys Hockey Trials

The selection process for the NSW All Schools 16 Years Boys Team has changed for 2018. CIS will be selecting a team of up to 13 players to go to the NSW All Schools Camp from where the state team will be selected. All entries will come in through associations. The process will be as follows:

Players 16 Years and Under will be accepted to trial and compete as members of Association Open Teams. Players who are 16 Years and Under who do not make their Association Team but are considered to have the strength, skill and maturity to still be considered, can be included in a second Association Team ie. A partial team entry for 16 Years and Under players only. Please note that the standard at the All Schools level is extremely high and we will only accept players who are turning **15 or 16 years** in the partial team nominations.

The timeline for both Open and 16 years and Under Nominations is as follows:

10 May 2018 - Open Boys Association Team Entry Due – Nomination of the intention to field a complete team at the CIS Championship/Trial – No Team Member names are required at this stage if you are fielding a complete team.

Partial Team Nominations from any Association **not** fielding a complete Open Team as well as any Partial Teams which include a second team of 16 Years and Under Players are also due. **ALL names of players in partial teams must be submitted by this date** so the complete trial format can be finalised.

17th May 2018 - Association Open Team Lists Due

Only Associations fielding complete Open Teams will submit names by this date. **ALL OTHER NOMINATIONS CLOSE ON 10 MAY.**

Both the Open and 16 Years and Under Boys Hockey Trials will be held on **24th May, 2018**. The format for the day will be finalised once Partial and Full Team entries have been received on the 10th May.

CIS Sports App 2018

All staff, and students nominated to attend a CIS Trials or Championship are required to download the App, **PRIOR** to the event. This will provide staff and students with the latest information regarding the trials for their sport, to access the app go to Google Play or the App store and download AISNSW. Once downloaded enter the relevant event code:

for all primary sports – primary18

for all Secondary Sports – secondary18

For windows phone or PC Users open any browser and go to <http://app.entegy.com.au/> insert relevant event code.

Please note that the Apps will be constantly updated until the event. Please keep checking for updates. When downloading the App please allow "Push Notifications". The App can be updated by clicking on the wheel in the top right hand corner of the screen.

N.B If you downloaded the App last year you need to put in one of the event codes listed above to access the 2018 information for your sport.

Don't forget to refresh your app to ensure you have the latest information on your sport.
