NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. CIS **does not** accept **late Nominations**.
2. All nominations **must** be submitted on line.
3. Nomination Forms are available on the CIS website under Nominations on the right hand side of each Sports Home page e.g. Baseball Page
4. **Check your nomination has been received** - you should be able to view your nominations under **My Profile > My Nominations** (you need to be logged in). If you cannot see it contact CIS.
5. Trouble with your nominations, contact **CIS before nominations close**.
6. If your **association is entering a team** to the CIS trials/ championships **you should not submit an individual nomination form** to CIS. The association team list will be submitted by your Association Delegate or your association convenor /representative for that sport.
7. Permission must be obtained from the **student's principal and parent/guardian** to for the student to attend the trial **before** submitting any online nomination form.
8. Sport nomination fee of **\$24.30** per nomination for all CIS Sports in 2018 with the exception of Triathlon.
9. Students who nominate but **do not attend the trial will be charged** if no notification is received prior to the trial date of their inability to attend.

NOMINATIONS FOR CIS SPORT

You can do this by going to your "My Nominations" area. If you can see the nomination there you know it has been received. If you cannot see it in your My Nomination area then try and resubmit.

Remember

NSWPSSA Team Official Nominations

School Sport Australian has approved NSWPSSA to field invitational teams at the 12 Years and Under Football Championships to be held in Sydney.

A requirement of this role will be to attend the School Sport Australia 12 Years and Under Football Championships from Monday 17 – Friday 21 September 2018.

Applicants are required to be full time teachers of primary schools and their appointments are subject to approval from their Principal/Director and the Sports Coordination Officer of their School Sport Association.

It is expected that applicants hold their mandatory first aid, CPR and anaphylaxis certificates.

Girls: turn 15 or less this year (born in 2003 or after).

Start Lists

Start Lists are available on the CIS website, Meet Mobile and the App. The most accurate start lists will be on Meet Mobile.

Live Results – Meet Mobile

CIS will once again be using Meet Mobile to assist with live results. A Flyer for Meet Mobile is loaded on the App and can be found under Related Documents on the Primary Swimming page of the website. Meet Mobile results now require a small subscription if you wish to access results.

To subscribe for results: Find a meet that is either in progress or completed, and go to events, and to an event that has results – that should trigger the screen to sign up for a subscription.

Pool Entry

Pool entry has been paid by all spectators and competitors in the CIS nominations levy. Entry to the pool will be free.

Parking Fee

The car park ticket will need to be validated to receive the \$15 flat rate.

Coaches must sign in at the recording room prior to the commencement of the carnival and have their WWC Numbers with them for verification. They will need to receive and wear a pass to be on Pool Deck.

Parents and Spectators

No parents or spectators will be allowed in the marshalling area or on pool deck. Each association has been assigned an area in the grandstand. On arrival students need to check in with their team managers who will be in this area. Photos in a Flash will be taking photos throughout the day.

Warm Up

Warm up procedures have been loaded on the app. Each association is to ensure that there warm up lane/lanes have supervision throughout the warm up period.

Marshalling

Swimming - Three calls will be announced and if swimmer doesn't show after that they will be scratched from the event. Only competitors are permitted in the Marshalling area, **parents and spectators are not allowed here or on pool deck**

Withdrawals / Changes at the CIS Championships

Associations are reminded that any student who does not compete and has been entered will be charged the nomination fee. If you are aware of a change / withdrawal please notify CIS (E: Mwebster@aisnsw.edu.au) by 5:00pm, **Tuesday 3 April**. After this time withdrawals will only be taken at the carnival from association team managers. Changes and withdrawals are to be listed on the withdrawal forms (in Managers Folders) and taken to Results and Recording enabling Meet Manager to be updated.

School Relay Teams

Relay swimmers must swim in the order listed on the Marshalling Sheets. This enables the times to be registered with Swimming NSW, ensures the correct athlete is acknowledged with the swim and for relay teams progressing to All Schools that the correct names are submitted.

Relay teams may wear either school or association Swim caps, however all members must wear the same i.e. all in school or association. Associations are reminded to leave 4 association caps at the Marshalling table at the beginning of the day.

CIS Secondary Swim Team

All swimmers who participate at the NSW CIS carnival should be available for selection in the CIS Team in the events in which they swim. Should this not be the case, individual association convenors should be notified so that they can inform the selectors prior to the meet.

Generally only those who compete at the CIS Championships will be eligible for selection in the CIS Secondary Swimming Team. Usually selections will be based on the fastest 3 times per event and the NSW CIS Selection Policy (see Operational Guidelines). **Students placing 1st, 2nd or 3rd must report to the Shane Gould Room to register, purchase uniform and pay the levy.**

Fourth place-getters are generally **reserves**. They are **not** entitled to purchase Team uniform but should report to the Shane Gould room to register as a reserve and collect information. **Reserves** should check the CIS



website regularly to see if their status has changed from reserve to competitor.

N.B. 17 Yrs. & 18 Yrs. (3 competitors per age per gender) 50m events and 100m freestyle will be swum as timed finals. While medals will be awarded to the first 3 in each age group, only the fastest 3 overall will progress to All Schools.

Multi Class selection for the CIS team subject to placing on the basis of classification and pathway qualifying standards and are not necessarily the result of the actual race. Official Places will be posted on the result board.

Selection in the CIS Team will be confirmed on the CIS website by Monday 9 April 2018

Please note:

At NSW All Schools and SSA Championships the maximum age for swimmers is turning 19 in the year of competition.

All Schools Withdrawals

Secondary swimmers selected to compete at All Schools who withdraw without a medical certificate after Friday 4 May will incur a fine of \$15.00 and may not be considered for further selection. Changes at the NSW All Schools Championships due to illness or injury will be at the discretion of the Team Managers.

CIS Secondary Diving Championships - Thursday 5th April

Marshalling - All competitors are requested to the marshalling area prior to their event to check their dive sheets.

Associations with athletes competing in both swimming and diving events at the CIS Championships should contact CIS asap so that clashes of events can be avoided wherever possible

NSW All Schools Diving Championships

The first 3 places in the CIS Championships will be selected to represent CIS at the NSW All Schools Diving Championships. These places will be announced at the conclusion of each event after the CIS presentation.

All divers selected to compete at the NSW All Schools must report to the Shane Gould Room to complete CIS uniform and levy payments at the conclusion of their event

CIS Sports App 2018

All staff, and students nominated to attend a CIS Trials or Championship are required to download the App, **PRIOR** to the event. This will provide staff and students with the latest information regarding the trials for their sport, to access the app go to Google Play or the App store and download AISNSW. Once downloaded enter the relevant event code:

for all primary sports – primary18

for all Secondary Sports – secondary18

For windows phone or PC Users open any browser and go to <http://app.entegy.com.au/> insert relevant event code.



Please note that the Apps will be constantly updated until the event. Please keep checking for updates. When downloading the App please allow "Push Notifications". The App can be updated by clicking on the wheel in the top right hand corner of the screen.

N.B If you downloaded the App last year you need to put in one of the event codes listed above to access the 2018 information for your sport.

Don't forget to refresh your app to ensure you have the latest information on your sport.
